

Karate BC NCCP Policy

Provincial Championships

In order to assure that Regional Coaching Staff are obtaining the proper training to provide their athletes with the best possible support, and in alignment with both Sport Canada Karate Canada expectations, Karate BC is establishing the following requirements for coaches who wish to participate in the Provincial Championships and other coaching related events.

- 1. In order to support athletes on the floor of 2014 Provincial Championships, all head coaches for each zone must have achieved Competition Introduction "Trained" status by having completed the course.
- In order to support athletes on the floor of 2015 Provincial Championships, all coaches
 for each zone must have achieved Competition Introduction "Trained" status by having
 completed the course.
- 3. In order to support athletes on the floor of 2016 Provincial Championships, all head coaches for each zone must have achieved Competition Introduction "Certified" status by completing the course evaluation process. Alternatively, they may seek Competition Development "in Training" status as this does not require Competition Introduction Certification but does require other pre-requisite training and completion of the four (4) Karate-specific modules provided by Karate Canada or the six (6) multisport modules.
- 4. In order to support athletes on the floor of 2017 Provincial Championships, all coaches for each zone must have achieved Competition Introduction "Certified" status by completing the course evaluation process.

BC Winter Games

- 1. All **Head Coaches** at the 2016 BC Winter Games are required to be **Competition** Introduction Certified.
- All Assistant Coaches at the 2016 BC Winter Games are required to have Make Ethical Decisions Certification.
