NCCP Professional Development Points Explained

As a new initiative to ensure that coaches across Canada are continually up to date, <u>Coaches Association of Canada</u> has unveiled their Professional Development Program. Professional Development points will also be required to maintain instruction and coaching certification. Below is a description of what is needed and how they are achieved.

Competition Introduction – 20 points over 5 years Instructor Beginner – 10 points over 5 years

In general:

- NCCP training or evaluation events are worth 5 points;
- Non-NCCP events are worth 1 point for each hour they last, up to a maximum of 3 points;
- "Active coaching" will give you 1 point per year;
- Through "Self-directed learning" you can earn a maximum of 3 points per five-year PD cycle.
